4 **Resolution declaring September 28, 2010 as Dr. Marguerite Rubenstein Day in San**
5 **Francisco to recognize her commitment to health education and her lifelong service to**
6 **San Francisco.**

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Marguerite Rubenstein was born in San Francisco and grew up in
9 Eureka Valley, as the daughter of a San Francisco Chronicle reporter; and

10 WHEREAS, She attended Mission High School and San Francisco State University
11 before earning her Ph.D. at The Institute of Advanced Study of Human Sexuality on Franklin
12 Street, where she was a founding faculty member and served as Dean of Students for many
13 years; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Rubenstein founded San Francisco Sex Information in 1972, an
15 organization that provides free, confidential, accurate and non-judgmental information about
16 sex and reproductive health, that is staffed by volunteers and still flourishing thirty years later;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, In 1976, she co-founded the San Francisco Bi-sexual Center, and late Bi-
19 Pol and the Bay Area Bi-sexual Network; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Rubenstein has been a dependable and active resident of Glen Park
21 for half a century; serving as part of the Glen Park Neighborhood Association and only
22 recently retired from the New Leaf Outreach to Elders advisory board after 11 years; and

23 WHEREAS, In 1992, she was selected to serve as Grand Marshal of the San
24 Francisco Pride Parade, one of the highest honors someone can receive from members of the
25 Lesbian, Gay, Bi-sexual and Transgender community; and

1 WHEREAS, In 1999, the GLBT Historical Society recognized Dr. Rubenstein for her
2 contributions to sex education and the legacy of the bi-sexual community; and

3 WHEREAS, Most recently, Dr. Rubenstein was awarded the Harry Britt Lifetime
4 Achievement Award by the Harvey Milk LGBT Democratic Club; and

5 WHEREAS, San Francisco is proud to be her home and congratulates Dr. Rubenstein
6 on the occasion of her 80th birthday; now therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors honor and recognize Dr.
8 Rubenstein for her amazing achievements, commitment to health education, and activism in
9 progressive causes which now includes the fight for universal health care in America, and
10 declares September 28, 2010 as Dr. Marguerite Rubenstein Day in San Francisco




