

1 [Grant to fund a project through the HIV Epidemiology Section, Department of Public Health.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to accept**
4 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$402,342 from the Centers for Disease Control and**
5 **Prevention (CDC) to support the Medical Monitoring Project (MMP); for the period of**
6 **June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010.**

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8 WHEREAS, The CDC is supporting DPH's HIV Epidemiology Section participation in
9 the MMP; in the amount of \$402,342, for the period of June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010;
10 and,

11 WHEREAS, The CDC is allocating funds annually but intends to fund the project for
12 five years if the grantee's progress is satisfactory, in which case DPH will get a total of
13 \$2,178,238 for five years; and,

14 WHEREAS, The MMP is a comprehensive population-based project to gather detailed
15 information on HIV-infected patients receiving care in the United States; and,

16 WHEREAS, San Francisco was announced as one of the study sites in the CDC grant
17 announcement (Funding Opportunity No. PS09-937) released March 9, 2009; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses
19 DPH for one existing position, Manager 1 (Job Class 0922) at .05 FTE for the period of June
20 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010; and,

21 WHEREAS, The budget includes \$392,484 in contractual services, which will be paid
22 to the Public Health Foundation Enterprises through a sole source contract; and,

23 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$1,501; now
24 therefore, be it

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1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
2 amount of \$402,342 from the CDC; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
4 grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
6 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
8 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
9 the agreement expires.
