

1 [Report of Assessment Costs for Blighted Properties]

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3 **Resolution approving a report of assessment costs submitted by the Director of Public**  
4 **Works for inspection and/or repair of blighted properties ordered to be performed by**  
5 **said Director pursuant to Chapter 80 of the Administrative Code, the costs thereof**  
6 **having been paid for out of a blight abatement fund.**

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8           RESOLVED, That after public hearings on July 14, 2010, July 28, 2010,  
9           August 25, 2010, September 8, 2010, September 22, 2010, October 13, 2010,  
10          October 27, 2010, December 8, 2010, December 22, 2010, January 12, 2011,  
11          February 9, 2011, and February 23, 2011 regarding any objections to the Director of Public  
12          Works for inspection fees pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 80 of the Administrative Code  
13          of the City and County of San Francisco, the costs thereof having been paid for by the City  
14          and County out of a Blight Abatement Fund, and after making such modifications, if any, as  
15          the Board of Supervisors deems necessary, the Board does hereby confirm said Report of  
16          Assessment costs described in Department of Public Works Order No. 179,280 and be it

17               FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution and a copy of said itemized  
18          Report of Assessment Costs confirmed by the Board shall be transmitted to the Controller and  
19          Tax Collector of the City and County, whereupon it shall be the duty of said officers to add the  
20          amount of each assessment to the next regular bill for taxes levied against each respective  
21          parcel of land, and thereafter each said amount shall be collected at the same time and in the  
22          same manner as ordinary City and County taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the  
23          same procedure under foreclosure and sale in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary  
24          taxes of the City and County; and be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That all monies received in payment of the assessments shall be  
2 credited to the Blight Abatement Fund provided for in Chapter 80 of the Administrative Code.
