The Sheriff's Department Oversight Board has attempted to fill the position, for which 5 Michael Nguyen was nominated, with an individual who is City a resident and who has 6 the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this 7 time. The Rules Committee has certified that Michael Nguyen is gualified to serve on 8 the Sheriff's Department Oversight Board. 9 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no 10 other possible representatives who is a resident of San Francisco, who has the specific 11 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to 12 serve on the Sheriff's Department Oversight Board at this time; and, be it 13 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement 14 for Michael Nguyen, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to 15 serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that otherwise requires 16 person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative 17 act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco. 18 19 20 21
