Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to install a four-way stop at the Paris Street and Amazon Street intersection and to install this four-way stop within 30 days after the Mayor signs the legislation.

WHEREAS, Paris Street runs through a residential neighborhood; and,

WHEREAS, Residents have reported that the Paris Street and Amazon Street intersection is a dangerous intersection where many accidents have occurred;

WHEREAS, Many residents have asked the Department of Parking and Traffic to put a four-way stop at this intersection; and,

WHEREAS, The speed limit for the area is 25 miles per hour; and,

WHEREAS, Many cars speed in excess of 40 miles per hour down Paris Street without concern for pedestrian safety; and,

WHEREAS, A four-way stop at the Paris Street and Amazon Street intersection would improve the traffic safety by slowing vehicles down; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to install a four-way stop at the Paris Street and Amazon Street intersection and to install the four-way stop within 30 days after the mayor signs the legislation.

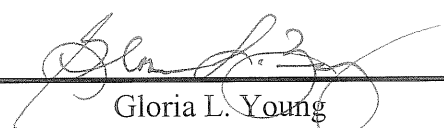

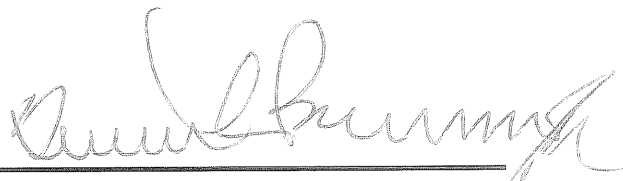
