

1 [Contracting Out Own Recognizance, Pretrial Diversion, and Misdemeanant Services]

3 **Resolution approving the Controller’s certification that own recognizance release,**
4 **pretrial court diversion, and supervised misdemeanor services provided to arrested**
5 **persons in the City and County of San Francisco can be practically performed by**
6 **private contractors at a lower cost for the year commencing July 1, 2002 than if work**
7 **were performed by City and County employees.**

9 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
10 Proposition J in November, 1976, allowing City departments to contract with private
11 companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than
12 similar work by City and County employees; and

13 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on May 15-16, 2002 that own recognizance
14 release, pretrial court diversion, and supervised misdemeanor services provided to persons
15 arrested in the City and County of San Francisco for the year commencing July 1, 2002 can
16 be practically performed by private contractors at a lower cost to the City and County of San
17 Francisco than if such services were performed by employees of the City and County of San
18 Francisco; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104.15 of the Charter, the Board of
20 Supervisors hereby approves said Controller’s certification.
