WHEREAS, Rabbi Martin S. Weiner made notable contributions to the spiritual life of Temple Oheb Shalom in Baltimore from 1964-1972 and as senior rabbi at Congregation Sherith Isreal in San Francisco from 1972-2003; and

WHEREAS, Rabbi Martin S. Weiner earned the accolade of “rabbi’s rabbi” through his work inspiring his congregation, his encouragement of young congregants to enter the rabbinate, and his many activities engaged in the pursuit of social justice and human rights; and

WHEREAS, Rabbi Martin S. Weiner provided outstanding leadership to the North American Reform Jewish movement as Vice President and then as President of the Central Conference of American Rabbis; now, therefore, be it
