3 **Resolution commending Carl Nolte for his distinguished career at the San**
4 **Francisco Chronicle; and declaring October 18, 2023, to be "Carl Nolte Day" in the**
5 **City and County of San Francisco.**

7 WHEREAS, Carl Nolte was born on August 21, 1933, and celebrated his 90th
8 birthday this year; and

9 WHEREAS, He is a proud, fourth-generation, San Franciscan native who
10 graduated from St. Peter's High School before attending City College of San Francisco,
11 and later received his Bachelor's from the University of San Francisco; and

12 WHEREAS, After graduating college, Carl served in the Third Infantry Division of
13 the United States Army Reserve and is a veteran of the Korean War; and

14 WHEREAS, Upon returning to the United States, Carl began his esteemed sixty-
15 two-year career at the San Francisco Chronicle on June 13, 1961; and

16 WHEREAS, During his time at the Chronicle, Carl has served as a journalist and
17 an editor, and spent time as a war correspondent, writing about the Gulf War, the
18 invasion of Iraq and the SS Jeremiah O'Brien; and

19 WHEREAS, Carl has won several awards for his work in journalism, including a
20 distinguished career award from the Society of Professional Journalists, a maritime
21 heritage award from the San Francisco Maritime Park Association, and holds honorary
22 degrees from the University of San Francisco and the California State University
23 Maritime Academy; and

24 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby commends Carl Nolte for his
25 decades of service at the San Francisco Chronicle and his unwavering dedication to the

1 field of journalism that has left an indelible mark on both the profession and the
2 communities he serves; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
4 San Francisco officially celebrates October 18, 2023, as "Carl Nolte Day" in the City and
5 County of San Francisco.
