AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, POPULATION HEALTH RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND PREVENTION, TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 FROM THE SAN DIEGO STATE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION FOR THE KIDS' PLATES BIKE HELMET SAFETY PROGRAM AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WHICH INCLUDES AN INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE AND WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES; PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION OF ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN.

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has applied for and been awarded a grant from the San Diego State University Foundation in the amount of \$5,000 to fund the Kids' Plates Bike Helmet Safety Program and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the San Diego State University Foundation requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 990263

WHEREAS, the San Diego State University Foundation has indicated that it will not agree to any modification to the form of the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the Agreement contains a certain provision described below which requires the approval of the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS. The Board of Supervisors desires to authorize the Department of Public Health, on behalf of the City, to enter into the Agreement in order to receive and expend the grant funds for this and any future years; now, therefore, be it

retroactively RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to-acceptretroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement in behalf of the City; and, be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the Agreement pursuant to which the City indemnifies the San Diego State University Foundation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification of the City by for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 6.57 (c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into similar agreements with the San Diego State University Foundation if the grant recurs or is renewed; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That although the City has incurred no legal obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify the action previously taken.
