3 **Ordinance adding Section 20 to the San Francisco Police Code regulating permitted**
4 **activities in City-owned parking garages.**

5 Note: This entire section is new.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

8 Section 1. The San Francisco Police Code is hereby amended by adding Section 20,
9 to read as follows:

10

Sec. 20. Permitted Activities In City-owned Parking Garages.

11

(a) No person may be present in a City-owned parking garage unless he or she is
12 engaged in one of the following activities or accompanying someone who is so engaged;

13

(1) Parking or unparking a vehicle or riding in a vehicle which is being parked or
14 unparked;

15

(2) Departing from after parking, or returning to, for unparking, a vehicle which is
16 parked in the parking garage;

17

(3) Using or going to or from a public restroom, if any, located in the parking garage;

18

(4) Using the facility or engaging in an activity authorized by the City, the Department
19 of Parking and Traffic or the Parking Authority.

20

(b) No person shall be cited for a violation of this Section until they have first been
21 provided with a written warning by a peace officer which shall be signed by both the officer
22 and the violator. If that person subsequently violates this Section, they shall be cited.

(c) Any person who violates the provisions of this Section shall be guilty of a
24 misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars or imprisonment for a
25 period not to exceed six months.

2 retail or commercial space:
