14	(2) Departing from after parking, or returning to, for unparking, a vehicle which is		
15	parked in the parking garage;		
16	(3) Using or going to or from a public restroom, if any, located in the parking gara		
17	(4) Using the facility or engaging in an activity authorized by the City, the Departmen		
18	of Parking and Traffic or the Parking Authority.		
19	(b) No person shall be cited for a violation of this Section until they have first been		
20	provided with a written warning by a peace officer which shall be signed by both the officer		
21	and the violator. If that person subsequently violates this Section, they shall be cited.		
22	(c) Any person who violates the provisions of this Section shall be guilty of a		
23	misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars or imprisonment for a		
24	period not to exceed six months.
