7	months term from July 1, 2025 to December 31, 2028, and for a total not to exceed
8	amount of \$436,382,686; and authorizing DEC to enter into any amendments or other
9	modifications to the amendment that do not materially increase the obligations or
10	liabilities, or materially decrease the benefits to the City and are necessary or advisable

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13	WHEREAS, On December 18, 2024, the Department of Early Childhood (DEC) issued
14	a Request for Grant Applications ("RFGA") for Access and Enrollment services by delivering
15	subsidy administration and resource and referral services; and
16	WHEREAS, Children's Council of San Francisco submitted a proposal and was one of
17	the highest ranked proposals; and
18	WHEREAS, DEC awarded the agreement to Children's Council of San Francisco in the
19	amount not to exceed \$436,382,686 for the period from July 1, 2025, through December 31,
20	2028; and
21	WHEREAS, and The City and County of San Francisco, by and through DEC now
22	wishes to enter into the Grant Agreement with Children's Council of San Francisco; and
23	WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by
24	Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any

contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

1	WHEREAS, The proposed Grant Agreement contained in File No, is
2	substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to
3	be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Grant Agreement in
5	substantially the form contained in File No; and, be it
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the DEC Director or
7	their designee to enter into any any amendments to the Grant Agreement, prior to its final
8	execution by all parties, that DEC determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, do not
9	materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City or materially decrease the benefits
10	to the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant Agreement,
11	and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and,
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Grant Agreement being fully
13	executed by all parties, DEC shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a
14	completely executed copy for inclusion in File No; this requirement and obligation
15	resides with DEC and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects
16	the validity of approved Grant Agreement.
