WHEREAS, due to a clerical error, a representative of the Southeast Alliance for Environmental Justice was printed twice; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall include only one representative of the Southeast Alliance for Environmental Justice, selected by the Southeast Alliance for Environmental Justice; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the member of the Board of Supervisors and 7 representatives of the Potrero and Lower Potrero Hill neighborhood shall be appointed by the President of the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the representative of the Public Utilities Commission shall be selected by the General Manager of the Public Utilities Commission.
