3 **Ordinance amending Article 16, Section 1137.5 of the San Francisco Police Code to**
4 **extend the taxi meter rate offset for the paratransit program to June 30, 2006.**

8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. Article 16, Section 1137.5 of the San Francisco Police Code is hereby
10 amended by amending Section 1137.5, to read as follows:

11 **SEC. 1137.5. INCREASED COST OF PARATRANSIT PROGRAM.**


12 From January 1, 2003 through ~~December 31, 2005~~ June 30, 2006, MUNI shall
13 calculate on a monthly basis the increased cost of paratransit scrip incurred by the paratransit
14 program as a result of the increase in rates of fare for taxicabs provided for in this Ordinance
15 or any increase in rates of fare for taxicabs resulting from the Controller's determination or
16 any modification thereof as provided for in Section 1137. The increased monthly cost of
17 paratransit scrip shall be divided equally among all taxicab permits in operation, to achieve an
18 average increased cost per taxicab permit for each month. From January 1, 2003 through
19 ~~December 31, 2005~~ June 30, 2006, that cost shall be allocated to color scheme permitholders
20 on a monthly pro rata basis, dependent on the number of taxicab permits affiliated with each
21 color scheme. By January 15, 2003, the Taxi Commission shall adopt procedures for
22 calculating and collecting appropriate sums from color scheme permitholders to offset the
23 increased monthly cost of paratransit scrip incurred by the paratransit program. If the voters
24 of the City and County of San Francisco reauthorize a new sales tax to fund transportation,
25 the Board of Supervisors shall convene a hearing to consider whether it is necessary to

1 continue the program designed to offset MUNI's increased paratransit costs pursuant to this
2 Section.


