

1 [Partial Settlement of Lawsuit]

3 **Ordinance authorizing partial settlement of the lawsuit filed by Tim Anderson,**  
4 **Alexandria Brunner-Jones, Rolando Canales, Davin Cole, Brian Devlin, Edward Allen**  
5 **Ellstad, Eugene Kalinin, Daniel Manning, Sonia Mariona, William Moralez, Brian J. Perry**  
6 **and Jack Z. Wronski against the City and County of San Francisco for \$240,000; the**  
7 **lawsuit was filed on November 5, 2003, in the United States District Court, Northern**  
8 **District of California, Case No. C-03-4928 MHP; entitled Eugene Kalinin, et al., v. City**  
9 **and County of San Francisco, et al; the partial settlement resolves certain claims in the**  
10 **lawsuit brought by plaintiffs Alexandria Brunner-Jones, Rolando Canales, Davin Cole,**  
11 **Brian Devlin, Eugene Kalinin, Daniel Manning and Sonia Marion; all plaintiffs have**  
12 **additional claims remaining in the lawsuit.**

14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

15 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to partially settle the action entitled  
16 Eugene Kalinin, et al., v. City and County of San Francisco, et al., United States District Court,  
17 Northern District of California, Court No. C-03-4928 MHP, by the payment of \$240,000.

18 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in the United States District Court,  
19 Northern District of California, on November 5, 2003, and the following parties were named in  
20 the lawsuit: plaintiffs are Tim Anderson, Alexandria Brunner-Jones, Rolando Canales, Davin  
21 Cole, Brian Devlin, Edward Allen Ellstad, Eugene Kalinin, Daniel Manning, Sonia Mariona,  
22 William Moralez, Brian J. Perry and Jack Z. Wronski; and defendant is the City and County of  
23 San Francisco.
