RE: Ord. 51-16/ File No. 150732

Ordinance amending Chapter 11D of the Building Code to extend the time for 1) compliance with the requirement that an existing building with a place of public accommodation either have all primary entries and path of travel into the building accessible by persons with disabilities or receive from the City a determination of equivalent facilitation, technical infeasibility, or unreasonable hardship, 2) the Department of Building Inspection’s report to the Board of Supervisors, and 3) the limitation on granting extensions of time; restating the findings of local conditions under the California Health and Safety Code and directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to forward the legislation to the California Building Standards Commission upon final passage.

The Building Inspection Commission met and held a public hearing on May 17, 2017 regarding the proposed Code amendments to the San Francisco Building Code referenced above. The Commissioners voted unanimously to support this proposed amendment.
