14	Section 1. Environmental Findings. The Planning Department has determined that the			
15	actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental			
16	Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is			
17	on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No and is			
18	incorporated herein by reference.

23	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of operating or maintaining a			
24	garage that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee for			
25	such garage of \$ <u>240.00270.00</u> per annum.

12	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting			
13	or operating a self-service station that requires a permit from the Fire Department, and jointly			
14	administered by the Fire and Health Departments, shall pay an annual license fee of			
15	\$ 240.00 270.00.

17	Section 5. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended			
18	by amending Section 94 to read as follows:			
19	SEC. 94. AUTOMOBILE PARKING STATIONS.			
20	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting			
21	or operating an automobile parking station that requires a permit from the Fire Department			
22	shall pay an annual license fee <u>of \$270.00 per year</u> as follows:			
23	(a) Automobile Parking Lots shall pay a license fee of \$240.00 per annum.			
24	(b) Parking structures with a total floor area of ten thousand square feet or less shall pay a			
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25 *license fee of \$240.00 per annum*.

17	(a) A public assembly unit with an occupant load of less than 100 persons shall pay an annual
18	license fee of \$240.
19	(b) An open-air assembly, other than a stadium or a structure with stadium-type seating shall
20	pay an annual license fee of \$240.
21	(c) An open-air assembly, stadium or structure with stadium-type seating shall pay an annual
22	license fee of \$240.

18	SEC. 240. STORAGE AND USE OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS.		
19	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing, using or		
20	transporting flammable liquids, including flammable liquid fuel oil, that requires a permit from		
21	the Fire Department, unless such person shall have secured a license under Sections 90 or		
22	93 of this Article, shall pay an annual license fee of \$270.00 per yearas follows:		
23	(a) For a flammable liquid storage tank located underground, \$240.00 per annum.		
24	(b) For flammable liquids stored above ground in bulk storage plants, \$240.00 per annum.		
25	(c) For flammable liquids stored above ground in processing plants, \$240.00 per annum.

1	(d) For an aboveground flammable liquid storage tank, located at other than a bulk storage	
2	plant or a processing plant, \$240.00 per annum.	
3	(e) For a portable tank (gas buggy), \$240.00 per annum.

17	petroleum gases or compressed gases that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall	
18	pay an annual license fee of \$ 240.00 270.00.

7	permit from the Fire Department, shall pay an annual license fee of \$240.00.

9	Section 14. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby		
10	amended by amending Section 243 to read as follows:		
11	SEC. 243. ERECTION AND USE OF ACETYLENE GENERATORS; STORAGE OF		
12	CALCIUM CARBIDE.		
13	Every person, firm or corporation installs uses an acetylene generator for which a		
14	permit is required for the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of $\frac{240.00270.00}{270.00}$.

16	Section 15. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby		
17	amended by amending Section 244 to read as follows:		
18	SEC. 244. APPLICATION OF FLAMMABLE FINISHES; AND USE AND OPERATION		
19	OF INDUSTRIAL BAKING AND DRYING OVENS.		
20	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of applying flammable		
21	finishes that requires a permit from the Fire Department; or using or operating an industrial		
22	baking and drying oven that requires a permit from the Fire Department, shall pay an annual		
23	license fee of \$240.00270.00.

5	titanium that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of			
6	\$ 240.00 270.00.

8	Section 17. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby

10	SEC. 246. OPERATING A TANK VEHICLE.			
11	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of transporting flammable			
12	liquids by tank vehicle, and providing such tank vehicle <i>that</i> requires a permit from the Fire			
13	Department, shall pay an annual fee of \$240.00270.00 for each tank vehicle.

18	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing and using a			
19	hazardous chemical that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual			
20	license fee of \$ 240.00 270.00.
