Hi President Mandelman and Supervisors,
Supervisor Wong recently "introduced a resolution urging San Francisco to prioritize restoring the City's **Outdoor Public Warning System**, beginning with **tsunami evacuation zones and coastal areas**, and to identify funding for this long-delayed public safety infrastructure." I urge you to consider that other cities have different warning systems that address more than tsunamis. In the event of citywide post-quake fires, we need to hear details from the Warning System, including what routes to take for an escape.

Restoring the old warning system does not meet the needs of the times. I urge you to advocate for a replacement and upgrade. to seek funding, and to get the job done with all deliberate speed.
