WHEREAS, On June 16,1998, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency condition on Jackson Street from Columbus Avenue to Kearny Street; and

**WHEREAS**, The existing 3x5 brick main sewer and the roadway above this area had collapsed, and immediate replacement was required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract No. CW-189E, "Jackson Street Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the existing 3x5 brick sewer with 18 feet of 24-inch diameter VCP sewer, 40 feet of 24-inch diameter PEP sewer, and 271 feet of 42-inch diameter RCP sewer; and

WHEREAS, The Contractor, JMB Construction, began the emergency work on June 17, 1998 and completed it on August 28, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water Repair and Replacement Program; and

WHEREAS, The cost of the project is projected to be \$285,821.00, of which \$237,271.00 is for the construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R, FAMIS Project No. CENRNRR981, Job Order No. 1609N); and

**WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an emergency; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the

emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on Jackson Street from Columbus Avenue to Kearny Street. **Public Utilities Commission**
