

1 [Advertising of bail bond agents.]

3 **Ordinance adding Section 710 to the San Francisco Police Code to require that**
4 **advertising for bail bond agents posted in San Francisco jails indicate whether the**
5 **agent maintains an office in San Francisco, requiring that the advertising agent be**
6 **licensed by the Department of Insurance, and requiring that the advertising agent**
7 **operating under a fictitious business name has on file a fictitious business name**
8 **statement.**

13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. The San Francisco Police Code is hereby amended by adding Section 710
15 to read as follows:

16 **Sec. 710. Advertising for bail bond agents in San Francisco Jails.**

17 (a). The Sheriff shall indicate next to all advertising for bail bond agents posted in San
18 Francisco jails whether or not each of the bail bond agents posting an advertisement maintains an
19 office in San Francisco.

20 (b) Prior to permitting an advertisement by a bail bond agent in the San Francisco jails, the
21 Sheriff shall require annually:

22 1. A copy of the agent's valid Department of Insurance license.

23 2. If the agent is operating under a fictitious business name, a copy of the fictitious business
24 name statement.

25 3. The physical office address or addresses of the business. Mail drops are not considered a
physical office address.

1 (c) If the agent's license status, fictitious business name, or physical office addresses changes,
2 the agent shall provide the information about that change to the Sheriff within seven calendar days of
3 the change.
