This Amendment Number Three ("Amendment") to the Services Agreement ("Agreement") between San Francisco Health Authority, a local governmental entity doing business as the **San Francisco Health Plan** ("Health Plan" or "SFHP"), and the City and County of San Francisco ("City"), a municipal corporation, acting by and through the San Francisco Department of Public Health ("SFDPH"), doing business as the **San Francisco Health Network** ("Community Supports Provider" or "SFHN"), is effective January 1, 2023. SFHP and Community Supports Provider are collectively referred to as "Parties" or individually as "Party".
