1 [Federal Funding – Emergency Shelter Grants Program]

3 **Resolution approving the 2005 Emergency Shelter Grants Program and Expenditure**  
4 **Schedule; and authorizing the Mayor on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco**  
5 **to accept and expend a \$923,756 entitlement grant under the Emergency Shelter Grants**  
6 **Program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development;**

9 WHEREAS, under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and Cranston  
10 Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of  
11 Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make a grant to the City and County of San  
12 Francisco under the Emergency Shelter Grants Program. The grant may be used for the  
13 rehabilitation or conversion of buildings for use as emergency shelters for the homeless, for  
14 the payment of certain operating and social services expenses in connection with emergency  
15 shelters, and for homeless prevention; and

16 WHEREAS, the Mayor will be able to use the grant monies to improve the operation of  
17 existing shelters and thereby enhancing the very basic living standards of homeless persons  
18 in the City; and,

19 WHEREAS, the grant monies will be devoted to provision of essential services for the  
20 shelters, payments for operating the shelters, and homeless prevention; and

21 WHEREAS, the Mayor's Office of Community Development has prepared an  
22 Expenditure Schedule designating the use of the \$923,756 Entitlement and \$14,801 in  
23 reprogrammed funds from prior year Emergency Shelter Grant Programs; and

1 WHEREAS, a Preliminary Environmental Record has been prepared on the proposed  
2 activities; and

3 WHEREAS, the Certifying Officer shall follow procedural provisions of NEPA to make  
4 certain that all projects are in compliance with the applicable federal provisions and  
5 requirements; and


6 WHEREAS, indirect costs have been allocated in the 2005 Community Development  
7 Block Grant (CDBG) Program to cover both CDBG and ESGP; now, therefore be it

8  
9 RESOLVED, that the Mayor's Office of Community Development is hereby  
10 authorized to apply for, accept, and expend the City's 2005 Emergency Shelter Program  
11 Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, transfer and expend  
12 reprogram funds from prior year Emergency Shelter Grants Program for \$938,557; and be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the  
14 Expenditure Schedule for recipient agencies; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation  
16 and certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.




