2 URGING THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT'S ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OFFICER TO TAKE  
3 REASONABLE STEPS TO ENSURE THAT, WHERE APPLICABLE, THE PLANNING  
4 DEPARTMENT'S TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES FOR ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW ARE  
5 UPDATED AND AMENDED TO INCLUDE A FULL ANALYSIS OF POTENTIAL IMPACTS  
6 TO BICYCLE TRANSPORTATION.

8 WHEREAS, The City Planning Department issues Environmental  
9 Impact Reports ("EIRs") which contain a section on "Transportation  
10 Impacts"; and

11 WHEREAS, The EIR transportation section analyzes, among other  
12 things, transportation impacts upon bicycle transit; and

13 WHEREAS, Examples of bicycle-related queries for sites that are the  
14 subject of EIRs would include analyzing existing and projected  
15 traffic counts for bicycles, inventorying existing bicycle parking at  
16 and near the site, and ascertaining any impact on bikeways and bike  
17 routes which are identified in the City's Master Plan, all of which  
18 would assist in the promotion of bicycle transit; now, therefore, be  
19 it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Planning  
21 Department's Environmental Review Officer to take reasonable steps to  
22 ensure that, where applicable, the Planning Department's  
23 Transportation Guidelines for Environmental Review are updated and  
24 amended to include a full analysis of potential impacts to bicycle  
25 transportation.


