

1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor’s Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ) to retroactively**  
4 **accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$986,643 from the U.S. Department of**  
5 **Justice (DOJ), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) for the**  
6 **purpose of renovating the Police Department computing environment and network**  
7 **infrastructure for the new Records Management System (RMS) application. The new**  
8 **system will provide a more efficient work environment, more accurate information and**  
9 **enhanced safety for both the public and officers.**

10 WHEREAS, MOCJ is the lead programmatic and fiscal agency in administering the  
11 2005 Technology Grant Initiative: San Francisco Police Department Records Management  
12 System Project; and

13 WHEREAS, San Francisco applied and was awarded on August 29, 2005, nine  
14 hundred eighty-six thousand and six hundred forty-three dollars (\$986,643); and

15 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department will be responsible for coordination  
16 and day-to-day operations of the planning and implementation phases of this grant; and

17 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department waived all indirect costs to maximize  
18 use of grant funds on direct services; and

19 WHEREAS, MOCJ will be responsible for the fiscal, programmatic and administrative  
20 reporting to the COPS Office; and now therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to  
22 retroactively accept and expend \$986,643 from the DOJ, COPS Office to administer the 2005  
23 Technology Grant Initiative: San Francisco Police Department Records Management System  
24 Project.
