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3 Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Planning Department to accept and expend
4 \$711,296 from the California Department of Housing and Community Development for

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8 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Planning Department was awarded a grant from the
9 California Department of Housing and Community Development's Workforce Housing Reward
10 Program for the period of December 20, 2007 through April 30, 2010 in the amount of
11 \$711,296; and,

12 WHEREAS, The grant supports the design and construction of specific pedestrian,
13 traffic calming, stormwater control, and intersection improvements along Cesar Chavez
14 Street; and,

15 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the State of California
16 Department of Housing and Community Development requires the City to enter into an
17 agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
18 Supervisors in File No. 081441; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as
19 if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an
21 amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and,

22 WHEREAS, The indirect costs are not included in the budget in order to maximize use
23 of grant funds on direct services; now, therefore, be it
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RESOLVED, That the Planning Department is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$711,296 from the State Department of Housing and Community Development; and, be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs; and, be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Planning is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.


