3 **Ordinance waiving the fee in Public Works Code Section 724.1(b) for temporary street**
4 **space occupancy in certain sections of the City on Saturday, May 5, 2007 as part of**
5 **Small Business Week.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. In order to promote Small Business Week, and permit sidewalk sales of
11 merchandise, the fee for temporary street space occupancy set forth in Public Works Code
12 Section 724.1, subsection (b), shall be waived on Saturday, May 5, 2007, between 7 am and
13 9 pm, in the following geographic areas of the City:

14 Grant Avenue between California and Washington Streets, east side of 3rd Street
15 between Newcomb and Oakdale Avenue, Mission Street between Cotter and Persia Streets,
16 Diamond Street between Bosworth & Surrey Streets, Chenery Street between Thor and
17 Castro Streets, Upper Market Street between Octavia Boulevard and Castro Street including
18 side streets, Castro Street between Market and 19th Streets including side streets, Mission
19 Street between 19th and 20th Streets, 21st Street between Valencia and Mission Streets,
20 18th Street between Dolores and Guerrero Streets, 17th Street between Valencia and Mission
21 Streets, Valencia Street between 23rd and 24th Streets, 24th Street between Dolores and
22 Diamond Streets, Church Street between Elizabeth and 24th Streets, Castro Street between
23 24th and 25th Streets, Ocean Avenue between Victoria and Capitol Streets, West Portal
24 Avenue between 15th Avenue and Uloa Street, and Leland Avenue between Rutland and
25 Bayshore Boulevard.

1 All other provisions of Public Works Code Sections 724 et seq. shall remain in full
2 effect.
