The attached is a Resolution from the San Francisco Board of Supervisors making a determination that the issuance of a Type-48 on-sale general public premises liquor license to Universal Life Corral, LLC, to do business as the Stud, located at 1123 Folsom Street, will serve the public convenience or necessity for the City and County of San Francisco. Resolution No. 562-23 (Board File No. 231104) was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 28, 2023, and signed by Mayor Breed on December 8, 2023.

3 **Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type-48 on-sale general public**
4 **premises liquor license to Universal Life Corral, LLC, to do business as the Stud,**
5 **located at 1123 Folsom Street (District 6), will serve the public convenience or**
6 **necessity of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California**
7 **Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4; and requesting that the**
8 **California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the**
9 **issuance of the license.**

11 WHEREAS, Universal Life Corral, LLC, is seeking the issuance of a Type-48 on-
12 sale general public premises liquor license to do business as the Stud, located at 1123
13 Folsom Street (District 6); and

14 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
15 zoned and recommends approval; and

16 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero protests and zero letters of
17 support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business
18 and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of
19 Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

20 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
21 following: 1) Except as provided in Condition 2 below, no noise shall be audible beyond
22 the area under the control of the licensee; 2) Any noise caused by entertainment or
23 amplified sound that is subject to the provisions of an active Entertainment Permit
24 issued by the San Francisco Entertainment Commission shall be authorized in
25 accordance with the limits established by that Entertainment Permit, including any

1 limitation on hours during which entertainment or amplified sound is permitted. A
2 violation of the entertainment or amplified sound noise conditions of the Entertainment
3 Permit, as determined by the San Francisco Entertainment Commission (or any
4 successor agency), shall be deemed to be a violation of this Condition. Any noise that is
5 not subject to, or is beyond the scope of, the Entertainment Permit shall be subject to
6 Condition I above. "Entertainment Permit" means any of the following: a Just Add Music
7 permit, a Limited Live Performance permit, a Place of Entertainment permit, a Fixed
8 Place Amplified Sound permit, or any similar such permit issued by the San Francisco
9 Entertainment Commission; 3) When the said outdoor patio area of the premises is
10 being utilized for the sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages, a premise
11 employee shall be in attendance and maintain continuous supervision at all times of
12 said area to ensure orderly conduct of patrons; and 4) Petitioner(s) shall actively
13 monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on
14 any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on the ABC-253; now,
15 therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
17 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
18 hereby determines that the issuance of a Type-48 on-sale general public premises
19 liquor license to Universal Life Corral, LLC, to do business as the Stud, located at 1123
20 Folsom Street, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of
21 San Francisco; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
23 San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police
24 Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
25 Control issue the license with those conditions.




