3 **Ordinance making environmental findings and amending the San Francisco Park Code**
 4 **by amending Section 12.08 to increase parking charges on Recreation and Park**
 5 **property; amending Section 12.09 to increase the fees for the carrousel; amending**
 6 **Section 12.15 to increase the fees for day camps; adding Section 12.29 to increase the**
 7 **fees for use of the photography center, adding Section 12.30 to increase the fees for**
 8 **participation in the latch key program, adding Section 12.31 requiring field trip**
 9 **reimbursements, adding Section 12.32 to increase the fee for resident golf cards, and**
 10 **adding Section 12.33 to increase fees for golf cart rental and driving range balls.**

14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

15 **Section 1. Making Environmental Findings.** *The Planning Department has determined that*
 16 *the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental*
 17 *Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file*
 18 *with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.*

19 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section
 20 12.08, to read as follows:

21 **Sec. 12.08. ~~KEZAR PARKING LOT~~ Parking Fees on Recreation and Park Property.**

22 (a) The following fees shall be charged for parking at the Kezar Parking Lot.

17 (b) Golden Gate Park. The fee for parking in all areas of Golden Gate Park, except for the
18 Music Concourse, shall be \$1.00 per hour, seven days per week.

19 (c) Candlestick Parking Lots.

20 _____ (1) The daily fee for vehicles and trailers parking in the television compound during
21 football season and for televised soccer events shall be \$1000 per day.

22 _____ (2) The fee for automobile and tire manufacturer and/or dealer shows shall be \$2,500.00
23 per day for set-up and breakdown and \$5,000.00 per day for the show.

24 _____ (3) The fee for car clubs shall be \$2,500 per day plus an additional \$1,250.00 for use of
25 the entire lot which includes the RV section.

1 (4) The fee for photography shoots shall be \$2,500.00 per day for use of the parking lot,
2 and \$4,000.00 per day for use of the stadium.

3 (d) Other Recreation and Park Property. The fee for parking on other Recreation and Park
4 property, except for garages and specifically designated parking lots subject to separate fee-setting
5 procedures, shall be \$1.00 per hour.

6 Section 3. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section
7 12.09, to read as follows:

8 **SEC. 12.09. CARROUSEL FEES.**

9 The following fees shall be charged for rides on the Golden Gate Park Carrousel:

10 Children 12 and under	\$.25	<u>\$.50</u>
11 Adults	\$1.25	<u>\$1.50</u>

12 Section 4. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section
13 12.15, to read as follows:

14 **SEC. 12.15. DAY CAMP FEES.**

15 The following fees shall be charged for Recreation and Park Department day camps.

1 (c) Priority will be given to San Francisco residents.

2 (d) The Recreation and park Commission shall adopt polices and procedures to offer a 50%
3 reduction in fees for low-income San Francisco residents, and to determine a discount for
4 families with two or more children attending Recreation and Park Department Day Camps.

5 Section 5. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.29,
6 to read as follows:

7 **Sec. 12.29. Photography Center.**

8 (a) The following fees shall be charged for use of the Photography Center for fiscal year 2003-
9 2004:

10	<u>Adult Annual Membership</u>	<u>\$250.00/year, unlimited use</u>
11	<u>Youth Annual Membership</u>	<u>\$125.00/ year, unlimited use</u>
12	<u>Adult</u>	<u>\$ 50.00/six months plus \$5.00/visit</u>
13	<u>Youth</u>	<u>\$ 25.00/six months plus \$5.00/visit</u>
14	<u>Senior</u>	<u>\$ 25.00/six months plus \$5.00/visit</u>

15 Section 6. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.30,
16 to read as follows:

17 **SEC. 12.30. Latch Key Program.** The following fees shall be charged for the Latch Key
18 Program, which provides recreational and tutorial programs, and a nutritious snack, after school and
19 during the summer at certain neighborhood recreation centers:

20	<u>School year (Monday-Friday)</u>	<u>\$ 30.00/month</u>
21	<u>Summer (Monday-Friday)</u>	<u>\$ 80.00/month</u>

22 The Recreation and Park Commission shall adopt polices and procedures to offer reduced rates
23 to low-income families.

24 Section 7. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.31,
25 to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 12.31. Field Trip Reimbursement.** *From time to time, field trips and outings are offered*
2 *as part of the Department's recreation programs. The Department shall collect a reimbursement fee*
3 *from participants to cover all, or a portion of, the costs of transportation, food, admission charges and*
4 *other associated expenses. If the full reimbursement required is \$10.00 per person, or less, the*
5 *Department shall charge the full amount. If the reimbursement required is more than \$10.00 per*
6 *person, the Department shall charge \$10.00, and an additional amount to cover at least 50% of*
7 *expenses over \$10.00 person. The Recreation and Park Commission shall adopt policies and*
8 *procedures to offer reduced rates to low-income families.*

9 Section 8. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.32,
10 to read as follows:

11 **SEC. 12.32. Resident Golf Cards.** *An annual fee of \$40.00 shall be charged for San Francisco*
12 *Resident Golf Cards, entitling the holder to discounts on the golf courses under the jurisdiction of the*
13 *Recreation and Park Department shall be available to San Francisco residents only.*

14 Section 9. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.33,
15 to read as follows:

16 **SEC. 12.33. Golf Carts and Driving Range Balls.**

17 *(a) The rental charge for golf carts at all golf courses under the jurisdiction of the Recreation*
18 *and Park Department shall be \$26.00.*

19 *(b) The following fees shall be charged for buckets of balls at Harding Park:*

<i>(1) small bucket (25-30 balls)</i>	<i>\$4.50</i>
<i>(2) medium bucket (45-50 balls)</i>	<i>\$6.50</i>
<i>(3) large bucket (70-75 balls)</i>	<i>\$9.50</i>
