3	Requesting a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$75,000 for the 2002-2003
4	fiscal year, and \$90,000 for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to support the operation of the San
5	Francisco Day Labor Program.

7	WHEREAS, The recent funding history of the Day Labor Program by the City of San
8	Francisco has been: 2000-2001 \$190,000;2001-2002 25,000; 2002-2003 \$25,000; and
9	WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2002, The Mayor's Office initiated a Request for Proposals
10	(RFP) for the grant money to administer the Day Labor Program, and,
11	WHEREAS, While the RFP was to be determined, in the interim the Mayor granted the
12	Day Labor Program \$25,000 to run the program from July to September 2002, with October 1,
13	2002 to be the start date for the new Day Labor Program contract; and,
14	WHEREAS, La Raza Centro Legal administered the program based upon a belief that
15	the RFP process would be finalized in a timely and fair manner; and,
16	WHEREAS, As of today, the contract to administer the Day Labor has not yet been
17	determined, Since October 1, 2002 the RFP process has twice been invalidated, with a third
18	RFP process not yet initiated; and,
19	WHEREAS, The Day Labor Program continues to be operated by La Raza Centro
20	Legal without any financial assistance from the City, the significant hardship to La Raza Centro
21	Legal includes staff pay cuts, and a reduction of agency wide office hours, and lay offs of less
22	senior staff; and Now Therefore Be It,
23	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors provide a supplemental appropriation in the
24	amount of \$75,000 for the 2002-2003 fiscal year, and \$90,000 for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to
25	support the operation of the San Francisco Day Labor Program.
