7 **MOVED,** That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Immigrant
9 Rights Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 5.201, for the
10 terms specified:

11 Almudena Bernabeu, seat 1, succeeding Vera Haile, deceased, must have a
12 demonstrated knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service, educational, or
13 employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion
14 of a two-year term ending June 6, 2016.

15 Haregu Gaime (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding herself, term
16 expired, must have a demonstrated knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service,
17 educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the
18 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending June 6, 2016.

19 Bill Hing, seat 3, succeeding himself, term expired, must have a demonstrated
20 knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service, educational, or employment issues
21 that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term

23 Leah Chen Price, seat 5, succeeding Teresa Chee, resigned, must have a

12 experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Immigrant Rights
13 Commission.

16 has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so
17 at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Haregu Gaime is qualified to
18 serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission.

20 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the
21 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is

24 for Haregu Gaime, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can
25 be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101, that requires person(s) appointed to boards,

I am a refugee myself, who fled from persecution in Belarus on account of political opinion. I speak six languages and deal with immigrant community on a daily basis, representing immigrants in Immigration Court, asylum office, before USCIS, and ICE. I volunteer twice or three times a month as a pro bono attorney of the day in San Francisco Immigration Court, representing immigrants in removal proceedings free of charge and thereby serving the interests of undocumented Hispanic population who do not have the wherewithal to hire private attorneys. Fluency in Spanish and compassion to undocumented immigrants is key to this type of work. I continue volunteering as a pro bono attorney with Asian Law Caucus in San Francisco, and provide free consultations on immigration issues to low-income Asian Pacific American communities in San Francisco and the Bay Area.

Almost three years of working as an immigration attorney in San Francisco and San Jose, doing removal defense, family and employment immigration, writing appellate briefs in removal cases and representing appellants before the BIA and the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. Conducting presentations on employment and family immigration, doing outreach to the community.





Phil Asgedom

1. Qualifications representing the communities of interest of San Francisco:

My family emigrated from Eritrea when I was six years old. San Francisco is home to a large immigrant community of Eritreans and Ethiopians. I understand who they are, their concerns, and their experiences.

Bevan Dufty asked me to help organize the Eritrean and Ethiopian communities because their input on the housing debate is absent though it is an issue of concern for the community. I have reached out to the owner of Oasis Café, a D5 resident and prominent member of the community, and I'm working on meeting with the owner of Radio Africa and Kitchen. In addition I'm reaching out to younger members of the community to help with the project.

I understand that immigrants leave their home countries for various reasons. Some are escaping dire circumstances while others leave the comfort of home in order to improve the lives of their children. I watched as my parents worked multiple jobs at once to provide and thrive in their adopted country. They hope that the productivity of their work and by raising responsible members of society that they have contributed to their adopted country. Through my personal experiences I know that immigrants are major contributors to our society and are also generally absent from the political process. My plan is to combine my personal experiences, my training as a community and labor organizer, and legal training to work productively with other board members.

I spent the last six years as a Union Organizer and Lead Negotiator with the Service Employees International Union (SEIU). Many of the union members were immigrants from around the world. The Union was typically on the forefront of immigration issues and we also worked closely with immigrant rights organizations.

I volunteered at the Eritrean American Community Center as a tutor and community organizer. In addition, while in college I spent one summer as a teacher assistant at an adult school that targeted immigrant adults.



My name is Leah Chen Price and I write to express my interest in joining the San Francisco Immigrant Rights Commission.

I am a San Francisco native, currently living in the Bayview neighborhood. For the past four years, I have been a practicing immigration attorney and immigrant rights' advocate. My practice focuses on removal defense and I've been privileged to know and learn from our local immigrant population. I regularly work with immigrants from all over the world as they seek protection from violence abroad, pursue reunification with their families, and immigrate to our city for a better, safer life.

Beyond representing immigrant clients, I have been active in organizing and fighting for stronger immigrants' rights. For the past two years I have co-chaired the National Lawyers Guild Bay Area Chapter Immigration Committee. We regularly organize our immigration attorney members to take pro bono cases, organize continuing legal education trainings, and serve as an expertise and support network for our members. The Immigration Committee was active in supporting the recent Due Process for All Ordinance to protect the basic due process protections of our immigrant community. This summer, the Committee has taken a leadership role in pursuing quality immigration representation for all of the Central American children who have crossed our border and made it to the Bay Area. I have attended meetings coordinated by the Unaccompanied Children Roundtable (convened by the Lawyers Committee for Civil Rights, Legal Services for Children, and the Immigrant Center for Women and Children) and serve on the Roundtable's Pro Bono Committee. We have been meeting regularly to strategize and energize the pro bono bar in the Bay Area to take Unaccompanied Minor cases.

In addition, I am a volunteer attorney with the Asian American Bar Association/Asian Pacific Islander Legal Outreach Clinic, the African Advocacy Network, Pangea Legal Services, and the Catholic Legal Immigration Network, Inc. (CLINIC). My pro bono experience has been rewarding in itself but in addition has given me incredible exposure to the pulse of our immigrant communities. I hear directly from my clients and their advocates where immigrants are struggling and how our city can address these issues.

My family also knows the immigrant struggle. My mother's family fled Communist China during WWII and landed in San Francisco under then-President Kennedy's refugee program. I know what it was like for my family to leave everything - safety, security, and home behind for the promise of a better tomorrow. I hold the immigrant community very close and will continue to advocate on its behalf. I know that I have a great deal of energy and expertise to contribute to the Immigrant Rights Commission and I look forward to this opportunity to act as a conduit between our city government and immigrant populations and to continue to serve the immigrant community.

The Immigrant Rights Commission consists of fifteen (15) voting members. Eleven (11) voting members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and the other four (4) voting members are appointed by the Mayor.

At least eight (8) members shall be immigrants to the United States who are appointed in accordance with Charter, Section 4.101. It has been past practice that six (6) of the immigrant members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and two (2) immigrant members are appointed by the Mayor. All members must have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco and shall reflect the geographic, ethnic, and sexual orientation population of San Francisco.

The term of each member of the Commission shall be two years; provided, however, that the members first appointed shall, by lot, classify their terms so that eight (8) members shall serve a term of three years and seven (7) members shall serve a term of two years. In the event a vacancy occurs during the term of office of any member, a successor shall be appointed to complete the unexpired term of the office vacated in a manner similar to that for the initial member.

The Immigrant Rights Commission shall advise and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor about issues affecting immigrants residing in San Francisco.
