

1 [Agreement Amendment - Westside Community Mental Health Center, Inc. - Behavioral  
2 Health Services - Not to Exceed \$23,347,118]

3 **Resolution approving Amendment No. 1 to the agreement between Westside**  
4 **Community Mental Health Center, Inc. and the Department of Public Health for**  
5 **behavioral health services, to increase the agreement amount by \$17,991,918 for**  
6 **an amount not to exceed \$23,347,118; and to extend the term by three years and**  
7 **six months, from June 30, 2019, for a total agreement term of July 1, 2018,**  
8 **through December 31, 2022.**

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10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health selected Westside Community  
11 Mental Health Center, Inc. (“Westside”) to provide behavioral and mental health  
12 services through a competitive solicitation; and

13 WHEREAS, Under this contract, Westside provides crisis, case management  
14 and mental health services to chronically mentally ill adult residents and to children,  
15 youth and their families in low-income neighborhoods impacted by trauma and violence;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, A copy of the original agreement is on file with the Clerk of the  
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. 190071, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
19 Resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of  
21 Public Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on  
22 behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to execute an agreement with Westside  
23 Community Mental Health Center, Inc. to increase the agreement amount by  
24 \$17,991,918 for a total amount not to exceed \$23,347,118 and to extend the term by

1 three years and six months, from June 30, 2019, for a total agreement term of July 1,  
2 2018, through December 31, 2022; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the  
4 Department of Public Health to enter into any amendments or modifications to the  
5 contract, prior to its final execution by all parties, that the Department determines, in  
6 consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interest of the City, do not otherwise  
7 materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to  
8 effectuate the purposes of the contract, and are in compliance with all applicable laws;  
9 and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract being fully executed  
11 by all parties, the Director of Health and/or the Director of the Office of Contract  
12 Administration/Purchaser shall provide the final contracts to the Clerk of the Board for  
13 inclusion into the official File No. 190071.
