2 URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO SCHOOL BOARD TO MEET WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO
3 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR A JOINT MEETING IN THE BEGINNING OF THE FIRST
4 QUARTER OF 1999 AS A TEST PILOT FOR FUTURE SUCH JOINT MEETINGS.

5 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District and the San Francisco Board of
6 Supervisors have access to limited resources and information working alone; and,

7 WHEREAS, It is in the City's best interest to strengthen and formalize the relationship between
8 the City and the San Francisco Unified School District by establishing mutually beneficial policies;
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The School District currently holds memoranda of understanding with several City
11 agencies; and,

12 WHEREAS, These two boards share mutual concerns for the well-being of the citizens of San
13 Francisco; and,

14 WHEREAS, The process of sharing City and County resources with the San Francisco Unified
15 School District has been typically achieved through specific, individualized schools rather than through
16 a more efficient and comprehensive centralized process; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge the San Francisco School Board
18 to meet with the San Francisco Board of Supervisors for a joint meeting in the beginning of the first
19 quarter of 1999 as a test pilot for future such joint meetings; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be sent to the San Francisco Unified
21 School District, 135 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102.




