

1 [Collaborative research study to evaluate the effectiveness of different approaches for  
2 reducing the transmission risk behaviors of HIV-infected patients, year 2.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
4 **enter retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$71,992 with The Regents of the**  
5 **University of California San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, for a**  
6 **collaborative study of prevention for HIV-positive persons under the second year of an**  
7 **award from the DHHS Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC); for the period**  
8 **of September 30, 2002 to September 29, 2003.**

10 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant from CDC for the conduct of a 3 year  
11 collaborative study titled "Prevention for HIV-Positive Persons"; and,

12 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of CDC, UCSF, and SFDPH to  
13 participate in this project; and,

14 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$71,992 for the  
15 second year of the award; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH to enter into a  
17 subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
18 Supervisors in File No. 031180, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
19 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$5,373;  
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
23 because we did not receive the subcontract from UCSF until May 15, 2003; and,

24 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
25 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually

1 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
2 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it


3 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract  
4 agreement in the amount of \$71,992 with UCSF, the primary contractor; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
6 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
8 funded under the agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when  
9 the agreement expires.
