9 Stockton Street Merchants & Property Owners Association, the San Francisco Neighborhood  
10 Association and other business people, merchants and leaders in the Chinatown community;  
11 now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports establishing a Chinatown Night  
13 Market Pilot Project on Grant Avenue between Washington and Broadway Streets, one  
14 evening per week between the hours of six and ten for three to four months beginning in  
15 September; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Public  
17 Works, the Department of Parking and Traffic, the Department of Building Inspection, the  
18 Police Department and other City Departments provide assistance in making a Chinatown  
19 Night Market Pilot Project a successful San Francisco event.
