11 required activities of any visitor to San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, Whether you are a first time tourist to the Castro or seasoned resident of
13 our beautiful city, the historical perspective that Trevor illustrates during this 3-hour
14 informative field trip is inspiring, educational, and fun; and,

15 WHEREAS, Trevor conducts Cruisin' the Castro more like a lecture, melding an
16 unbiased view of human behavior together with historical events; and,

17 WHEREAS, Cruisin' the Castro emphasizes the documenting of gay and lesbian
18 heritage as an important component in the struggle to dispel the stereotypical images of gays
19 and lesbians; and,

20 WHEREAS, Gay Pride 1999 marks the tenth anniversary of the Cruisin' the Castro;
21 now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the City and County San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby
23 commends Trevor Hailey for ten years of leading Cruisin' the Castro walking tours of Castro




