18	funded by the State Lead Case Management Control grant for FY 2005-2006 and FY 2006-		
19	2007; and,		
20	WHEREAS, the State Department of Lead Case Management Control has approved		
21	the inclusion of a new position in the budgets of the San Francisco Childhood Lead		
22	Prevention Program for FY 2005-2006 and FY 2006-2007 in the total cost of \$66,011.40;
