2 COMMENDING THE WOMEN'S COMMUNITY CLINIC AND ITS DEDICATED
3 VOLUNTEERS FOR OPENING A CLINIC IN THE HAIGHT-ASHBURY TO SERVE
4 WOMEN'S HEALTH NEEDS.

6 WHEREAS, The residents of San Francisco are in great need of health services
7 targeted to and run by women; and,

8 WHEREAS, The Women's Needs Center, which had been in operation since 1969,
9 was forced to close in February 1999 due to budgetary problems; and,

10 WHEREAS, The closing of this facility left thousands of women to look elsewhere for
11 free medical care; and,

12 WHEREAS, A group of dedicated volunteers has been working since then to raise
13 money to re-open the clinic; and,

14 WHEREAS, Their efforts resulted in \$100,000 in corporate and individual donations
15 and city contracts; and,

16 WHEREAS, The clinic re-opened last week under a new name, the Women's
17 Community Clinic; and,

18 WHEREAS, The clinic will serve an estimated 2,000 women per year free of charge,
19 providing vital services such as pregnancy testing, Pap tests, HIV testing, breast exams, and
20 general medical screenings; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors
22 commends the Women's Community Clinic and its dedicated volunteers for opening a clinic in
23 the Haight-Ashbury to serve women's health needs; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board transmit a copy of this resolution
25 to the Women's Community Clinic.
