Resolution consolidating the following elections, all of which will be held on March 5,

2024: the State of California's Presidential Primary Election; the City and County of San

Francisco Municipal Election; the City and County of San Francisco's Special Bond

Election; and the elections of the governing bodies of local political parties; and

providing that the election precincts, voting places, and officers for these elections

WHEREAS, The State of California will hold a Presidential Primary Election on March 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting on candidates for federal and state offices, as well as a proposed state ballot measure to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will hold a municipal election on March 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting on proposed local ballot measures to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has called a special election to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on March 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting on a proposed general obligation bond measure, and consolidated the special municipal bond measure election with the Presidential Primary Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco's local political parties, the Democratic Party, Green Party, Peace and Freedom Party, and Republican Party will hold elections on March 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting on candidates for their governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors believes that it is in the best interests of the public that these elections be consolidated, as authorized by law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to California Elections Code, Section 10400 et seq., the State of California's Presidential Primary Election, the City and County of San Francisco Municipal Election, the City and County of San Francisco's Special Bond Election, and the elections for local political party governing boards on March 5, 2024, shall be and hereby are consolidated; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the voting precincts, polling places, and officers of the State of California's Presidential Primary Election, the City and County of San Francisco Municipal Election, the City and County of San Francisco's Special Bond Election, and the elections for local political party governing boards, shall, in every case, be the same; that there shall be only one set of election officers in each precinct, to wit, the election officers to be appointed by the Director of Elections for each precinct; that all candidates, ballot measures and bond proposals shall be set forth on the ballots provided for said election; that the elections shall be held in all respects as though there were only one election, and that all returns shall be canvassed by the Director of Elections as provided in the California Elections Code.
