18 Association Executives and the California Association of Convention and Visitors Bureaus;

21 WHEREAS, Dale Hess is a founder of the Western Association of Convention and
22 Visitors Bureaus; and,

24 WHEREAS, Dale Hess currently serves on the Board of Directors of Coming Home, a
25 San Francisco community-based support organization that provides fiduciary services to the
aged and terminally ill, and the American Society of Association Executives; and,

WHEREAS, In 1985 Dale Hess was named Association Executive of the Year by the
Northern California Society of Association Executives and received their first Lifetime
Achievement Award in 1997; now, therefore, be it
