RESOLVED, That, pursuant to the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, the following intersections are hereby designated as "STOP" intersections, and the Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "STOP" signs to be installed thereat as designated below:

## STOP SIGNS – ESTABLISH

- 25th Street and Minnesota Street, stopping Minnesota Street, making this uncontrolled intersection a two-way STOP;
- Hampshire at 17th Street, stopping Hampshire Street, the stem of this T-intersection;
- Cesar Chavez Street at Castro Street, stopping Cesar Chavez Street, making this uncontrolled intersection a two-way STOP;
- Edna Street at Joost Avenue, stopping Edna Street, the stem of this T-intersection;
- Ankeny Street and Ordway Way, stopping Ankeny Street, making this intersection an All-Way STOP; and,
- Hudson Avenue at Cashmere Street, stopping Hudson Avenue, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.
