Resolution initiating a landmark designation under Article 10 of the Planning Code of Gregangelo & Velocity Art & Entertainment, located at 225 San Leandro Way, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 3253, Lot No. 015.

WHEREAS, Under Planning Code, Section 1004.1, the Board of Supervisors may by Resolution initiate landmark designation; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Art & Entertainment has been an invaluable neighborhood asset in District 7 for over 30 years and contributes to the unique arts and culture of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Since 1979, this address, now known as The Gregangelo Museum, is the home and studios of Gregangelo Herrera, a queer artist of half Lebanese and Mexican descent, born and raised in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Art & Entertainment is a cultural hub of the Westside, bringing creativity and curiosity to countless San Franciscans and visitors alike, and serves as a shining example of the alternative lifestyle quintessential to San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Art & Entertainment has welcomed people from all walks of life to a warm meal and a warm welcome, embodying San Francisco's values of inclusivity and inclusion; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Art & Entertainment is headquartered in a completely restored Mediterranean-style home that was originally constructed in 1920, and to this day, the home maintains the original footprint, all of the original oak floors, plaster, old-growth redwood structure, and gardens unique to San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Within this historic structure are countless art installations, projects, and structures that create a new world of discovery for all who visit. These art exhibits are unlike anything found across San Francisco and the Bay Area and add to the historic and irreplaceable quality of 225 San Leandro; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Art & Entertainment has partnered with other arts institutions across the City, including the Yerba Buena Center for the Arts, the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco, San Francisco Asian Art Museum, the Moscone Center, and many more; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Arts & Entertainment offers enriching internships to young artists, welcomes creators from across the globe, and has been featured in many media outlets, including TEDx, Netflix, HGTV, and Univision; and

WHEREAS, Gregangelo & Velocity Arts & Entertainment has served as an alternative place of healing, acceptance, and creativity during times of crisis, such as the AIDS epidemic, earthquakes, economic downturns, global disasters, and the COVID-19 pandemic for more than 40 years and has been able to support creative individuals in surviving against formidable odds; now, therefore be it
