8	WHEREAS, The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the San Francisco
9	Police Department and the San Francisco Police Officers Association governs compensation,
10	benefits, and working conditions for members of the Department; and
11	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is currently experiencing significant
12	fiscal challenges, and it is critical to ensure that all City expenditures are transparent, fiscally
13	responsible, and aligned with City priorities; and
14	WHEREAS, The economic provisions of the MOU, including but not limited to base
15	pay, premium pay, bonuses, retirement contributions, and other incentives, represent a
16	substantial financial obligation to the City; and
17	WHEREAS, A comprehensive audit of these provisions is necessary to understand
18	their cumulative financial impact and to assess how they influence the City's long-term budget
19	outlook and public safety outcomes; and
20	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has the authority under Charter, Section 2.114,
21	to request audits of City operations to ensure effective and efficient use of public funds; now,
22	therefore, be it
23	MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst, in coordination with the Controller's
24	Office, is hereby directed to initiate a comprehensive audit of all economic components of the
25	Memorandum of Understanding between the Police Department and the Police Officers

1	Association, including a detailed analysis of all pay provisions, incentives, and financial
2	impacts associated with the agreement, and their effect on the City's overall budget.
