

1 [Renew Joint Powers Agreement with State]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively contract for, accept and expend up to \$2,249,136**
5 **allocated from the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board for a**
6 **project entitled the Joint Powers Agreement for the period of July 1, 2009 through June**
7 **30, 2012.**

9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to enter into an agreement
10 with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board in accordance with
11 Government Section 13835 for the purpose of assisting victims and witnesses with
12 compensation claims; and

13 WHEREAS, Funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that
14 would, in the absence of California victim Compensation and Government Claims Board
15 Programs, be made available to support the assistance of victims and witnesses of crime;
16 and,

17 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded "G" in the District
18 Attorney's budget; and

19 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

20 WHEREAS, The District Attorney requests that indirect costs be waived in order to
21 maximize use of funding on contract-related activities; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
23 the grant budget; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San
25 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to contract for,

1 accept and expend funds from the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims
2 Board to continue the Joint Powers Agreement, including any extensions, augmentations or
3 amendments thereof.
