Section 1. Findings.

SEC. 12.43. JUNIOR AND FAMILY GOLF TOURNAMENTS.					
(a) <u>A Junior Tournament is a group of 16 or more players, age 17 and under. The following</u>					
fees will be charged for Junior Tournaments, carts not included for Fiscal Year 2007-2008.					
Thereafter, Junior Tournament fees will be 50% (fifty percent) of the resident tournament fee for the					
applicable course.
