| 9  | WHEREAS, When national publicity about the Summer of Love brought hundreds of                 |
| 10 | thousands of young people to San Francisco with no thought of how to provide for              |
| 11 | themselves, the Haight Ashbury Free Clinic was at the frontlines of providing specialized,    |
| 12 | nonjudgmental health care to deal with the waves of drug addiction, STDs, and bad trips; and, |
| 13 | WHEREAS, The Haight Ashbury Free Clinic began as an all-volunteer project that                |
| 14 | opened at 8PM every night in addition to maintaining a 24-hour telephone hotline, with Dr.    |
| 15 | David Smith volunteering three or more hours every night after working full-time as the       |
| 16 | director of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Screening Unit at San Francisco General Hospital;      |

| 18 | WHEREAS, In 1973 Dr. David Smith worked with Bill Graham to provide emergency                 |
| 19 | medical care at Grateful Dead and Led Zeppelin concerts at Kezar Stadium; which spawned       |

| 21 | event medicine; and,  |
| 22 | WHEREAS, The Haight Ashbury Free Clinic lives up to the highest ideal that health             |
