WHEREAS, The Visitacion Valley Branch Library is currently among the smallest of the branch libraries in the San Francisco Public Library system; and,

WHEREAS, The Visitacion Valley Branch Library is now housed in rented property that is in deplorable condition; and,

WHEREAS, The Visitacion Valley Branch Library serves a growing and diverse population of residents, including youth from four schools in the surrounding area; and,

WHEREAS, Over the past five years, demand for library services at the Visitacion Valley Branch Library has increased tremendously, with circulation growing by as much as 20 percent over the past year alone; and,

WHEREAS, The Visitacion Valley Branch Library has received grants to install eight personal computers, however due to the current space constraints and the insecure nature of the building, branch administrators are unable to expend the grant to install the personal computers; and,

WHEREAS, Neighborhood activists and library administrators have been working together to address the impending crisis at Visitacion

Valley Branch Library brought about by the increasingly unsafe conditions and the lack of space; and,

WHEREAS, There is widespread support among the Visitacion Valley community for providing a permanent space for the library by purchasing the existing space, as well as the adjacent space that is currently available, and renovating the building; and,

WHEREAS, The need for the library to find a new and permanent location is pressing given the unsafe nature of the current location; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the Library Commission, the San Francisco Public Library, the City Librarian, and the Mayor's Office to work with the Visitacion Valley Branch Library to acquire a permanent space for the branch immediately.
