The Office of the Mayor Behested Payment Waiver Report

October 31, 2025 – April 30, 2026

Legislative Requirement

On October 28, 2025, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 515-25 approving a waiver of the City's Behested Payments Ordinance (Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code, Sections 3.600 et seq.) for the Mayor, City Attorney, City Administrator, officers and employees under the supervision of the Offices of the Mayor, City Attorney, and City Administrator, and the heads of each division office, and department under the City Administrator's supervision for a period of six months beginning on October 31, 2025. Resolution No. 515-25 included a requirement for the Office of the Mayor to submit a report to the Board of Supervisors detailing donations solicited under this waiver within 60 days of the expiration date of the waiver (June 29, 2026).

The Office of the Mayor Behested Payment Reporting

The Office of the Mayor has established successful public-private partnerships to support the City's efforts related to immigration, LGBTQ+ rights, reproductive rights, environmental protection, and racial equity, ensuring City residents are treated fairly, with dignity, and consistently with local, state, and federal law.

The Office of the Mayor did not solicit behested payments from interested parties under this waiver for services related to Immigration, LGBTQ+ Rights, Environmental Protection, Reproductive Rights, and Racial Equity. There are no additional behested payments that were solicited outside of this waiver from non-interested parties.
