3 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND  
4 \$350,000 IN FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT FOR THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY  
5 (TEA21) FUNDS GRANTED THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE  
6 COMMUNITIES PROGRAM OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR  
7 THE PIONEER PARK PROJECT WITH REQUIRED LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS OF  
8 \$40,250.

9 WHEREAS, The United State Congress enacted the Transportation  
10 Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (TEA21) in June 1998, which made  
11 approximately \$14.4 billion available in federal funds to the  
12 California Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

13 WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) has  
14 created the Transportation for Livable Communities (TLC) capital  
15 grant program to provide funding for bicycle-, pedestrian-, and  
16 transit-oriented developments that are eligible under the criteria  
17 set forth in MTC Resolution 3127; and

18 WHEREAS, the MTC has recommended the programming of \$350,000 in  
19 federal funds through its TLC program for capital improvements at  
20 Pioneer Park; and,

21 WHEREAS, The federal funding will cover 88.5 percent of eligible  
22 costs, as defined by the Federal Highway Administration and  
23 administered by the California Department of Transportation; and,

24 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible, according to Federal  
25 Highway Administration rules and regulations; and,



4 Friends of Recreation and Park; and,


5 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has authorized the Director of

8 be it


9 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize
