

[Public Employment and Accept-Expend State Grant – Sheriff’s Department project to address the needs of mentally ill offenders in the jails.]

Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 203-06 (Annual Salary Ordinance 2006-2007) to reflect the addition of a 2932 Senior Psychiatric Social Worker in the Department of Public Health and a 8444 Deputy Probation Officer in the Adult Probation Department, and authorizing the Sheriff’s Department to accept and expend an 18-month grant in the amount of \$995,128 from the Corrections Standards Authority for the Mentally Ill Offenders Crime Reduction (MIOCR) Grant Program, and waiving indirect costs.

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Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Grant Funds.

The Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized to accept and expend on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco \$995,128 in grant funds from the Corrections Standards Authority for the Mentally Ill Offenders Crime Reduction Grant Program. The grant period is from January 01, 2007 to June 30, 2008. The Sheriff's Department is further authorized to furnish whatever additional information or assurances the funding agency may request in connection with this grant, and execute any and all agreements necessary to complete the transfer of funds. As set forth in Resolution File No. 061650, the Sheriff's Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs, hereby waiving indirect costs.
