WHEREAS, Harry Britt authored ballot measures to create the o Office of Citizens Complaint in the Police Department, the Department of Parking and Traffic and the San Francisco transportation authority as well as the ½ cent sales tax to support the transportation authority; and,

WHEREAS, Harry Britt authored many significant pieces of domestic partners legislation during his tenure and authored Proposition K, the successful domestic partners ballot measure passed by the voters in 1990; and,

WHEREAS, Harry Britt continues to serve the citizens of San Francisco in his role as an instructor at New College; and,
